The Educational Consultant Training Program (ECTP) for teachers working with children who have cochlear implants

The Educational Consultant Training Program of The Children's Hospital of Philadelphia prepares teachers of the deaf and hard of hearing to serve children with cochlear implants in educational settings and cochlear implant centers. Participants of the program — the only one of its kind in the U.S. — obtain intensive training to provide leadership in the development and implementation of auditory-oral educational programs for children who have cochlear implants. The program has regional sites in Philadelphia, Atlanta and the San Francisco Bay area.

Upon completion, participants will receive nine graduate credits from Smith College.
